- To promote understanding indigenous and endemic flora and their habitats and encourage greater awareness of the importance of flora and their habitats.
- To integrate ecological principles derived from Maori and Western environmental thought and practice throughout policy, planning, and practices of indigenous flora and their habitats.
- To actively protect and restore rare endangered threatened vulnerable or unique indigenous species of flora and develop significant public support for indigenous flora.
- To develop and maintain a collection of indigenous flora in order to conserve and enhance their valuable genetic resources and support through the collection and supply of plants, others who are restoring habitats and developing collections.
- To be culturally aware and consult if appropriate.
